Equipment and Training Cooperative Agreement

We the undersigned recognize that sharing knowledge and resources among these three departments will provide many benefits to all. The benefits may include: Reduced maintenance, training and certification costs; Standardized equipment, training and certification sources which will help make our mutual aid responses more effective, and: Improving our main mission which is to provide emergency public services. Recognizing these goals and benefits, the undersigned agree to the following:

- 1. To cooperate in the purchasing, maintenance, repair and certification of firefighting and rescue equipment, and to share our various maintenance, repair and calibration facilities where-ever such cooperative arrangements provide a mutual benefit;
- 2. To cooperate in ongoing fire-fighter and EMT training by maintaining a pool of qualified, certified instructors, holding joint certificated training classes and sharing training equipment such as practice dummies, videos and facilities:
- **3.** To cooperate in the ongoing search for grants and other financial aid resources, and to cooperatively apply for said grants and aids where possible, especially when purchasing PPE and Fire/Rescue equipment;
- 4. To aim, in as much as possible, to standardize fire-fighting equipment such as Structural PPE, SCBA's, First Aid training Equipment, etc.
- 5. That each department will pay be its fair share of the costs involved in the above, said cost determination, billing and accounting services to be provided by North San Juan Fire District's Business Manager. Technician and instructor training costs will be borne by the individual's department. Each department will contribute equally to the annual equipment calibration costs, as determined for each project enjoined to the agreement.
- 6. That each department agrees to hold harmless and indemnify each other in the event of liabilities incurred by one department. Each department agrees to provide its own commercial and professional insurance coverage and in no way rely on any other undersigned entity to provide liability protection.
